



2026 FAWE/MASTERCARD FOUNDATION PHASE II PROGRAMME (TVET) BURSARY AWARDEES ZIMBABWE



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NOTICE ON SELECTION PROCESS

The selection of bursary awardees was undertaken through a rigorous, transparent and multi-tiered process. Applications received nationwide were first screened for eligibility before being reviewed by Provincial Selection Committee comprising 21 members (11 females, 10 males) drawn from the Ministry of Primary and Secondary Education, the Ministry of Public Service, Labour and Social Welfare (Department of Social Development and Disability Affairs) and representatives from each of the six partner TVET institutions (Harare, Bulawayo, Mutare, Gweru, Kwekwe Polytechnics and Belvedere Technical Teachers College)

Shortlisted candidates were subsequently validated by a National Selection Committee drawn from Ministry of Higher and Tertiary Education, Innovation, Science and Technology Development (MHTEISTD), Tertiary Education Service Council (TESC), Ministry of Women Affairs, Community, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MWACSMED), Ministry of Public Service, Labour and Social Welfare (Department of Disability Affairs and the Commissioner for Refugees), Leonard Cheshire Disability Zimbabwe, FAWEZI Executive Committee (Vice Secretary), Alumni and Secretariat. The process applied a structured scoring matrix, gender and provincial equity considerations, and inclusion measures for persons with disabilities and refugees.

Final selections were further confirmed through home verification visits to validate applicants' eligibility and vulnerability status. The individuals listed are therefore those who successfully met all programme criteria following this comprehensive review and verification process.



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
